WHAT IS A COOKIE?

A cookie is a small data file stored on your computer or mobile device at the request of your browser when you visit this Website. The cookie allows the website to “remember” your actions or preference for a certain period of time. Most browsers allow cookies by default. However, users can set their browsers to refuse or remove them, if they wish.

There are different types of cookies:

- **Session cookies** are deleted when you close your browser.
- **Permanent cookies** remain on your device or computer until they expire or until you actively delete them. They enable certain information about your use to be recalled when you return to the website.

A cookie can temporarily store anonymous information about the use and users of a website.

WHAT COOKIES DOES SANOFI USE ON THIS WEBSITE?

Some cookies are necessary to be able to use the website, others allow customization and optimization of the content displayed, the collection of user preferences or the monitoring of the audience of the website, website errors and the securing of its access.

On our Website, we and our service providers use permanent cookies.

SANOFI is using cookies if you have properly consented through the cookies banner. If your consent is already given, the banner will not appear again as long as the cookie expiry term has not come to an end. If you do not want our Website to install cookies on your browser, you

can disable cookies on the cookie settings page or by modifying your browser settings. In this case, certain pages of the Website may not function properly.

On this Website, we use cookies to measure audience and your use of the Website and to improve it.

| _gid | This cookie name is associated with Google Universal Analytics. Store and update a unique value for each page visited | 24 hours |
| External_referer | This cookie is set by Twitter to identify and track the website visitor. | Session |
| fr | Used by Facebook to deliver a series of advertisement products such as real time bidding from third party advertisers. | 3 Months |
| Guest_id | This cookie is set by Twitter to identify and track the website visitor. | Session |
